The Clemmons FOOD PANTRY is a local non-profit organization providing supplemental groceries to residents in need throughout Forsyth County.

The Clemmons Food Pantry's mission is to provide more people, more often, with more food. In 2016, they provided over 300,000 pounds of food to Forsyth county families.
